

places any three cards from hand into their scoring pile.

Otherwise, Crown player picks a partner, who may not be the Shield player; they will be the Crown Team. All other players are on the Shield Team, if any.

Displayed cards should be sorted by trumpiness (super, major, minor, not a trump).

Play

Crown leads the first trick; winner of each trick leads the next trick. You may play from hand or or display. You must follow suit if possible.

Trumps are no longer considered their own suit but a special Trump suit. If trump is yellow 2 and the lead is green 4, you can't trump it with a green 2 unless you have no other green.

When you win a trick, add it to your score pile.

Play until all hands are empty.

Scoring

Each player scores the number of point icons on their cards (left centre).

If the sum of all Crown Team points equals or exceeds the

number on the Crown indicator, each of them gets the Bid Bonus (number of cards bid \times 10. If not, the Shield team wins and each member gets their Bid Bonus (number of cards \times 5)).

Each member of the winning team scores the number of points shown on the Trump token their leader chose.

Dealer chooses a player other than themselves as next dealer.

Goal

Have the most points after 3-4 hands.

Setup

Choose a number of hands to play.

Randomly pick a first dealer.

③: remove all cards of one colour.

③ Crown player takes the three face-down cards into hand, then
